

Fun Drop Stitch Scarf

A quick, easy knit, that creates a beautiful accessory for any time of the year.



Yarn: 2 skeins of Knit One, Crochet Too's Ambrosia (137 yds per skein). Color shown: Papaya.

Gauge: Not critical. This pattern can be worked in all different weights of yarns by simply adjusting your needle size.

Materials: US 6 needles.

Cast on: 25 stitches

Rows 1-4: Knit

Rw 5: Knit

Rw 6: Purl

Rw 7: Knit

Rw 8: Knit

Rw 9: Purl

Rw 10: Knit 1, *yarn over twice, knit 1, repeat from *

Rw 11: Purl, dropping all yarn overs as you come to them.

Repeat rows 5-11 until scarf measures approx. 60", or desired length.

Work rows 4-8 once.

Knit 4 rows even.

Bind off all stitches and weave in ends. Block lightly.
